

Affiliation Proposals for Scottish Squash AGM 2010.

A: The existing cost of affiliation is replaced by a per team charge for every team playing in a local open league and a small charge for every member of the club, irrespective of whether the club is 'Court hiring' or 'Owning'.

B: Clubs' that affiliate would be required to provide the name, address and email address of up to 10 'competitive members' per team. These 'competitive members' would be able to access all the current facilities offered by Scottish Squash but they would not have an individual vote at Scottish Squash's AGM.

C: Clubs' that affiliate are also required to provide the name, address and email address of all their members. Club voting rights would be one vote for every 10 such named members. Those members other than the 'competitive members' would be known as 'club player/supporters'.

D: The 'Individual' class of membership to be removed from the Articles of Association. This would prevent players from non affiliated clubs accessing Scottish Squash competitions and services.

E: Individuals who are not resident in Scotland may apply for 'Membership of Scottish Squash' and thereby play in Scottish Squash events.

F: An existing affiliated club whose region is not affiliated to Scottish Squash would continue to access all facilities offered by Scottish Squash.

New Membership Scheme Charges.

The cost per team is set at £225. (See 'A' above)

The cost for all club members is set at £1 per member. (See 'B' above)

The junior competitive player is set at £10. I.e. a junior who plays in regional tournaments.

A junior playing in a senior team in the local open league and listed by the Club under the 'team fee' would be classed as a 'competitive player'. No extra fee would be payable.

A Region who affiliates to Scottish Squash would be required to pay an annual fee of £50.

'Membership of Scottish Squash' is set at £30. (See 'F' above)

An existing affiliated club who under the new scheme would pay more will have their fee for the season 2010/2011 frozen for one year at the current cost. There after they would be required to pay according to the new scheme.

Incentives.

From October 2010 a Club may claim a reduction in their annual affiliation fee for each of the following:

£30 for every UKCC Level 2 Coach and £50 for every UKCC Level 3 Coach.

£30 for every Grade 2 Referee and £50 for every National Grade Referee.

From October 2011 (for the season 2010/2011)

A Club may claim a reduction in their affiliation fee of £25 for every junior team playing in a local junior league or tournament with a minimum of 3 players per team. Minimum of 12 matches per league or 4 tournaments with 12 matches.

Cost comparisons with the existing scheme.

Court Hiring: Assumption: Club has twelve members and names 7 players per team

Existing scheme, £120 + 7 @ £19 + 5 @ £5-50p = £290.50

New scheme, 1 team @ £225 + £12 = £237.

Court Owning: Assumption: Club has sixty members and 3 teams and names 7 players per team

Existing scheme, £250 + 21 @ £19 + 39 @ £5-50p = £863.50

New scheme, 3 teams @ £225 + £60 = £735.
