## General entry guide and regulations

- 1. The events will take place on 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> September 2010 at Newlands Lawn Tennis Club, 18, Mochrum Road, Glasgow, G43 2QL.
- 2. The monrad system or round robins will be used.
- 3. The Championships will be played under the rules of the WSF and the Scottish Squash and Racketball Code of Conduct and Fair Play Statement will apply.
- 4. All matches will be the best of 5 games and the Dunlop Pro XX yellow-dot ball will be used.
- 5. Scoring used must be PAR 11 as adopted by the World Squash Federation.
- 6. Players MUST check in at the tournament desk at least 30 mins prior to the start of play.
- 7. Players will be required to mark and referee matches.
- 8. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
- 9. All competitors in this series of events will be listed in order-of-merit according to the Scottish Squash Matrix. The top 4 entrants go straight into Premier Division 1 while all other entrants are divided into groups of 8 players. A single Qualifying round will be played between players in these groups of 8 with the winners taking the remaining 4 places in the Division above and the losing 4 players taking the seeded positions in the Division below. This continues until all players have qualified into monrad draws of 8 players who then complete 3 further rounds of play.
  - Player's finishing position within their Division will then count towards Squash Matrix points for future events.
- 10. All players must compete in all scheduled matches, both main draw and play-off matches. Failure to complete all matches will result in participants being suspended from the following event and no points being awarded unless an appropriate medical certificate explaining a sound reason for this failure is provided to the Scottish Squash and Racketball Event Co-ordinator within the working week following the event.
- 11. Scheduled match times are a guide only players are expected to be available to follow on immediately previous matches are complete.
- 12. Junior players (under 19 on the last day of the event) will be required to wear appropriate eye protection in line with Scottish Squash and Racketball's Eye Protection Policy.
- 13. For junior players, results will also contribute to their Age Ranking on the basis of their overall finishing position in the Tournament.
- 14. Players enter and play in the West Regional Junior A Graded Open at their own risk. Scottish Squash and Racketball and Newlands Lawn Tennis Club do not accept any responsibility for injury arising from participation in the tournament. Competitors who are not Individual Competitive Player Members of Scottish Squash and Racketball are advised to arrange their own Personal Accident insurance cover.
